

NAME istat -- get inode status

SYNOPSIS istat___ [filesystem] inumber₁ ...

DESCRIPTION istat___ gives information about one or more i-nodes on the given file system or on /dev/rk0 if no file system is given.

The information is in exactly the same form as that for stat(I), except that mode letter "a" is used to indicate that the i-node is allocated, "u" that it is unallocated.

FILES /etc/uids, /dev/rk0

DIAGNOSTICS --

BUGS istat___ ignores any read error and pretends to give status even if the file system is not physically present.
