SYNOPSIS

**comm** [ – [ **123** ] ] file1 file2

## DESCRIPTION

Comm reads file1 and file2, which should be in sort, and produces a three column output: lines only in file1; lines only in file2; and lines in both files.

The output is written on the standard output.

Flags 1, 2, or 3 suppress printing of the corresponding column. Thus **comm** –**12** prints only the lines common to the two files; **comm** –**23** prints only lines in the first file but not in the second; **comm** –**123** is a no-op.
